INSURANCE AND WORKERS' COMPENSATION

The Montpelier Public School System carries basic special risk insurance and additional catastrophic coverage that insures students engaged in Community Based Learning program activities.

Any student involved in paid Community Based Learning program activities **MUST** be covered under the employer's Workers' Compensation policy.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In the event that a student has an accident or other emergency at his/her Community Based Learning site, the site supervisor will immediately:

1. Take appropriate emergency action, i.e., call 911 or apply first aid, and
2. Notify Montpelier High School at 225-8000.

After notification, Montpelier High School will:

1. Coordinate/arrange for further emergency action,
2. Contact the student's parent/guardian, and
3. Follow up on the accident or emergency with the parties involved.
