We have a limit of 5 guests per dance. Guest forms are accepted up to the day of the dance no later than 3:00 or until five guest forms have been returned (whichever happens first).

No guest forms are accepted upon arrival at the dance.

Crafters Edge Dance Rules:

Dances are a privilege. Any student not following the rules will be asked to leave. Their parents will be notified immediately and the student will not be allowed to the next dance.

1. Students absent from school, suspended, or in the planning room and not signed out by the end of the day are not allowed to go to the dance.
2. **Students should not arrive at a dance or be on school property until 10 minutes prior to the dance.** Only the four DJ's and the two dance coordinators are allowed in at 6:30 for set-up. All dances run from 7:30-10:00. **When the sixth grade only dance is held it will run from 7:00-9:00.**
3. NO food, gum or beverages in the gym.
4. Students are not allowed to leave the dance early unless they have written permission from their parents, or a phone call home is made.
5. Only students of Main Street Middle School are allowed to the dances. Five guests per dance are allowed only if the Principal and the Crafters Edge instructors prior to a dance have approved them. **(Showing up at the door with guest not pre-approved is not allowed.)** Guest forms are available in the Family Consumer Science room.
6. All jackets, backpacks, etc. are to be placed in the Family Consumer Science room to be picked up at the end of the dance.
7. Other than the DJ's no students are allowed behind the DJ table.
8. Students are expected to follow directions the first time they are given by any supervising staff member. Students are expected to respond appropriately to all reasonable requests.
9. Students are expected to respond to others in a courteous and respectful manner. Students are expected to use language that is polite and appropriate.
10. Students may not hurt, bully, or harass another individual either verbally, in writing, physically, or by throwing objects or equipment. Fighting, rough housing, name-calling, teasing, harassment, bullying or profanity will not be tolerated. Students will keep their hands and feet to themselves.
11. Dance style should be appropriate for middle school children!

Dance Dress Code is as follows:

- Skirt and Shorts - The bottom hem of all shorts and skirts must not be above the midpoint of the individual's thigh.
- No strapless tops or tops that expose the back or belly. Spaghetti straps are allowed, but the shirts cannot be low cut or see-through.
- Pants cannot be worn below the hip-line.
- No clothing may make reference to any type of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or contain inappropriate or offensive language of any type.
- *STUDENTS who do not follow the dress code will be asked to call home for a change of clothes.*
